NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF REPORTING DEADLINE

The Maine Supreme Judicial Court announces the extension of the date for reporting qualifying pro bono hours for the 2014-15 Katahdin Counsel Program reporting year¹ from September 15 to **September 30, 2015**.

Maine lawyers generously perform countless hours of pro bono work that typically go unrecognized. The Katahdin Counsel program seeks to quantify and recognize those efforts.

Although Maine lawyers often shun public recognition for their good works, it is vitally important for the court and the profession to be able to show, in concrete numbers, the contribution that these lawyers make to the larger community.

The court invites and encourages Maine attorneys to submit their certifications of service within the extended deadline for qualification for the 2015 Katahdin Counsel Program.²
