Non-English Language ACTFL Oral Proficiency Interviews (OPI)

Date/Time: Week of February 6, 2017 various times

Location: Administrative Office of the Courts, 125 Presumpscot Street, Portland

Deadline: Scheduled on an individual basis; Candidates that score 70 or above on the January 25th written exam will receive an e-mail invitation by close of business on January 26, 2017

Fee: \$40 for first attempt; \$80 for subsequent attempts
