Fee: \$25 for first attempt; \$50 for subsequent attempts.

### **Non-English Language ACTFL Oral Proficiency Interviews (OPI)**

Date/Time: Week of June 12, 2017 various times  
Location: Administrative Office of the Courts, 125 Presumpscot Street, Portland  
Deadline: Scheduled on an individual basis. Candidates that score 70 or above on the written exam will receive an emailed invitation by close of business on June 5, 2017  
Fee: \$40 for first attempt; \$80 for subsequent attempts
