I. Purpose:

The Judicial Education Committee is established to organize and administer continuing judicial education (hereinafter, “CJE”) opportunities for Maine’s Judiciary.

II. Membership:

The Judicial Education Committee will be comprised of two Superior Court Justices, two District Court Judges, one Family Law Magistrate, and one Supreme Judicial Court Justice. The Chief Justice will designate the Chair. The members of the existing Judicial Education Committee shall continue to serve on the Committee until January 1, 2015. Thereafter, the Supreme Judicial Court shall appoint members to a term of three years, subject to reappointment to a second term. The appointment of a member filling a vacancy on the Committee shall begin a new three-year term.

III. Meetings:

The Judicial Education Committee will meet on a schedule established by the Chair and approved by the Committee. The Judicial Education Committee will meet no less than twice a year.

IV. Reporting:

The Judicial Education Committee will report to the Supreme Judicial Court and the Trial Court Chiefs as requested by the Chief Justice.
