
On April 15, 2015 the Court noticed the parties for a status conference to be held on May 4, 2015 regarding the disability suspension of William B. Cote.

R. 7.3(e)(4) and 7.3(j), Mr. Cote may file a Petition for Reinstatement and related Questionnaire with the Executive Clerk and the Board of Overseers; however he is not permitted to return to practice unless and until the Court grants such a Petition.
