


**STANDING ORDER REGARDING  
2025 JUDGMENT INTEREST RATES**

Due to an administrative error, the Judicial Branch promulgated incorrect pre-judgment and post-judgment interest rates for 2025.<sup>1</sup> The error was corrected on April 1, 2025, as follows:


	Incorrect Original	Corrected Update
<u>Pre-Judgment interest rate</u> if complaint is filed or notice of claim is served in 2025	7.88%	<b>7.23%</b>
<u>Post-Judgment interest rate</u> for a judgment entered in 2025	10.88%	<b>10.23%</b>

To address this error, it is therefore ORDERED that, for any judgment affected by the incorrect interest rates, upon the written request of any party to the matter, the clerk is authorized to issue a corrective writ of execution with the correct rates without any further order of the court.
