I. Coming October 23rd

- Maine eCourts is the Judicial Branch's new eFiling, online payment, digital court records, and electronic case management system.
- We have partnered with Tyler Technologies (Tyler) to implement Odyssey, a suite of products that support the electronic processing of court functions and forms.
 - Odyssey is the most widely adopted commercial court case management system nationwide, spanning 29 states, over 700 counties, and 15 statewide implementations.
 - Maine eCourts is the system you will use to electronically file with the Courts.

I. Coming October 23rd

- Violations Bureau was successfully implemented statewide in October of 2018.
- The *Bangor District Court, Penobscot County Superior Court,* and the statewide *Business and Consumer Docket* went live in November of 2020, with all Family (*FM, Probate, and Child Protection*) and Civil case types, *except for protection from abuse, protection from harassment, and civil violation cases*.

I. Coming October 23rd

Maine eCourts will go-live on Monday, October 23rd in the Lewiston District and Androscoggin Superior Courts.

- All Family & Civil cases types, except for protection from abuse, protection from harassment, and civil violation cases will be included.
- Starting Monday, October 23rd, paper case documents will no longer be available for the identified case types in the courts that have implemented Maine eCourts. Electronic access will be available through reSearchMAINE.

II. Electronic Access

re:Search MAINE

- **reSearchMAINE** is an online case look up and search service. Access to electronic case information.
- Electronic access to cases is governed by the <u>Maine</u> <u>Rules of Electronic Court Systems</u>.
- Seamless access from your Maine eCourts account.
- reSearchMAINE is a new tool that is replacing the Odyssey Portal

a. Create a reSearch Account. Use the same email address you provided to the Court.

III. Electronic Filing

- eFiling procedures are governed by the <u>Maine Rules of</u> <u>Electronic Court Systems</u>.
- eFiling is required for Attorneys in courts where Maine eCourts has been implemented. M.R.E.C.S Rule 33(B)
- Although Email filings are still permitted under <u>pmo-sjc-3</u>, the eFiling of GAL and Mediation reports through <u>eFileMaine</u> is strongly encouraged.
