
The State of Maine moves, pursuant to 15 M.R.S. §1098, to revoke the post-conviction bail in this case, and states as follows:






My basis for probable cause is:



Mr. Cutler has demonstrated that he has no intent of following his ordered conditions and is simply searching for ways to circumvent them.


It is obvious that he does not intend to take advantage of probation and treatment, therefore probation will not be a benefit.






My basis for probable cause is:




