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DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO AMEND
BAIL CONDITIONS TO ALLOW FOR
CONFIDENTIAL COUNSELING

NOW COMES Defendant, by and through undersigned counsel, and hereby moves this Court for the entry of an order amending Defendant's bail conditions to allow him to have confidential counseling via video, and states as follows:

1. Defendant's current conditions require that he have a supervisor for all of his internet use. Additionally, Defendant's bail conditions prohibit him from having access to the internet after 5:00 p.m. Defendant is appreciative of the court's allowance for Defendant to have all of this access.

2. Defendant currently engages in counseling by video with Robert Klotz and Maureen Halmo as required by his probation conditions. Defendant also attends Sexual Addicts Anonymous groups by video, and those sessions take place from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm on Wednesdays.

3. Given the confidentiality of Defendant's counseling, as well as the confidentiality and anonymity associated with his SAA meetings, having a supervisor directly observing Defendant at all times during these specific sessions removes any confidentiality associated with those sessions and also makes it difficult to have the open and honest communications necessary for a counselor-patient relationship.

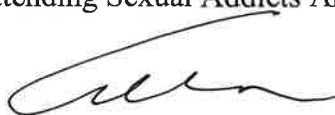
4. Given this, Defendant requests that his conditions of release be modified to indicate that Defendant's internet supervision with respect to counseling does not require continuous supervision, but does require random, unannounced checks by any supervisor of Defendant to ensure compliance with the internet access restrictions. Additionally, Defendant requests that the internet access restriction that prohibits access after 5:00 pm be modified to allow Defendant to have access from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm on Wednesdays for the sole purpose of attending Sexual Addicts Anonymous meetings.

5. Amending the supervision provisions in Defendant's bail conditions would not compromise the strength and integrity of the conditions, especially given that Defendant is already

subject to having all of his internet activities monitored by RAN as required by his probation conditions.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Defendant respectfully requests this Court enter an order amending Defendant's bail conditions as they relate to supervision of his counseling with Robert Klotz, Maureen Halmo, and SAA, insofar as supervision with respect to this internet access shall be random and unannounced, and further requests that the internet access restriction that prohibits access after 5:00 pm be modified to allow Defendant to have access from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm on Wednesdays for the sole purpose of attending Sexual Addicts Anonymous meetings.
