
NOW COMES, Intervenor and Appellant, Protect Girls Sports Ballot Question Committee (“the Committee), and moves for relief from the page and word limitations in Rule 7A(f)(1) allowing the Committee fifty (50), rather than forty (40), pages for the Committee’s principal brief and 12,269 words rather than 10,000 words.

The complexity of the issues presented and the abbreviated time frame available for the drafting and finalization of the Committee’s brief prevented undersigned counsel from editing further in the time available.

WHEREFORE, Intervenor and Appellant, Protect Girls Sports Ballot Question Committee respectfully moves this Court to allow the Committee’s principal brief as fifty (50) rather than forty (40) pages and 12,269 words rather than 10,000 (omitting discussion of Petitioners’ cross-appeal).
