On May 26, 2026, the Secretary of State issued her Final Decision pursuant to this Court's direction in its Decision and Order of April 24, 2026.

At this Court's direction, Counsel for all parties conferred on May 29, 2026 and have agreed to the following schedule and procedures for the filing of the record and briefs.

1. Respondent Secretary of State shall produce the Record to the parties no later than Monday, June 1, 2026 and file the Record with the Court no later than Tuesday, June 2, 2026.

2. In accordance with Paragraph 3 of this Order, the parties shall submit electronic copies of briefs to this Court by e-mail, followed by hard copies filed with the Clerk of Court, in accordance with the following schedule:

A. Petitioners, Jane Gilbert, *et al.*, and Intervenor, Protect Girls Sports in Maine Ballot Question Committee, shall submit their initial briefs with the Court by email on or before 11:59 p.m., Wednesday, June 3, 2026;


B. Respondent shall submit its responsive brief with the Court by email on or before 11:59 p.m. on Friday, June 5, 2026;

C. Petitioners and Intervenor shall submit their reply briefs with the Court by email on or before 11:59 p.m. on Monday, June 8, 2026.

3. All filings submitted pursuant to Paragraph 2(A)-(C) shall be made by electronic mail sent directly to this Court via clerk Mark Caldwell at his court email address by the deadlines set out above. All parties shall also thereafter file a hard copy of each filing with the Clerk of the Superior Court for filing by the day following the deadlines set forth in Paragraph 2(A)-(C).
