

This matter is before the Court on Defendant's Motion to Dismiss or For Summary Judgment. Plaintiffs did not file an opposition to the motion in accordance with M.R. Civ. P. 7(c). Accordingly, Plaintiffs have waived all objections to the motion. M.R. Civ. P. 7(c).

In this action, Plaintiffs seek to recover from for Defendant's alleged fraud and breach of fiduciary duty with respect to Defendant's involvement in the financing for Morse Brothers, Inc., a corporation of which Plaintiffs were the principals.
